Purpose: At Oasis Sainik School, the admission process is more than just a screening for academic eligibility—it is a comprehensive and forward-looking assessment aimed at identifying young individuals with the potential to thrive in a structured, disciplined, and holistic residential environment. The Admission Test serves as a critical tool to evaluate the overall readiness of the child and the family for the school's unique academic, physical, and value-based ecosystem.

1. Baseline Academic Assessment: Gauging Learning Levels and Readiness

Purpose: To assess the child's current academic standing in key areas such as English, Mathematics, and General Awareness.

Rationale: This helps us:

- Understand the student's foundational knowledge to provide appropriate academic support or enrichment.
- Identify learning gaps early to plan remedial or extension programs.
- Ensure that students can effectively cope with the CBSE curriculum and the rigorous academic framework that includes competitive exam preparation, including for NDA and SSB in higher grades.

2. Physical Fitness and Endurance Evaluation: Building NDA-Oriented Cadets

Purpose: To evaluate the child's physical stamina, agility, motor coordination, and enthusiasm for sports and physical challenges.

Rationale: Physical fitness is not just encouraged—it is a way of life at Oasis Sainik School. This assessment helps us:

- Identify students who can benefit from our structured sports and fitness programs.
- Select cadets with the potential to be groomed for National Defence Academy (NDA) preparation and defence careers.
- Promote early inculcation of discipline, resilience, and a healthy lifestyle.

3. Personality, Emotional and Social Readiness: Ensuring Residential Suitability

Purpose: To assess the child's emotional independence, social behavior, self-regulation, and adaptability to a structured residential environment.

Rationale: A residential school demands more than academic ability—it requires self-discipline, adaptability, and emotional resilience. Through informal interactions and behavioral observations, we assess:

- The child's comfort in being away from home and ability to form healthy peer relationships.
- The emotional maturity required to manage routine, structure, and responsibility.
- The parents' mindset and preparedness to support the child's growth in a residential setting, maintaining healthy communication and trust in the school's approach.

4. Interest and Aptitude in Co-curricular and Extracurricular Activities

Purpose: To identify the child's natural interests and talents beyond academics—be it in sports, music, arts, debates, or leadership roles.

Rationale: Our school aims to produce well-rounded individuals, not just academically successful students. We nurture talents in:

- Athletics, team sports, and martial arts to build physical strength and leadership.
- Music, art, dramatics, and literary clubs to foster creativity and confidence.
- Leadership development, through student councils, assemblies, and SSB-style training.

A child's involvement and enthusiasm in these areas often reflect their potential for personal growth, team spirit, and long-term success in life.

5. Alignment with School Vision and NDA Readiness

Purpose: To ensure the child and parents understand and resonate with the long-term goals of the school, including the structured path to defence careers via NDA.

Rationale: Oasis Sainik School is a grooming ground for tomorrow's leaders—particularly those aspiring to serve the nation through the armed forces. We aim to:

- Prepare students academically, physically, and psychologically for NDA and other competitive opportunities.
- Align the child's aspirations with the school's offerings and mentoring ecosystem.
- Ensure that the school's disciplined, high-expectation environment matches the student's ambition and family vision.

It reflects our commitment to grooming cadets who are not only academically competent but also physically fit, emotionally balanced, culturally aware, and nationally inspired.

Eight-Stage Admission Procedure

For Classes VI to IX and XI

At Oasis Sainik School, the admission process is structured, transparent, and designed to identify students who are aligned with the school's academic goals, physical training, residential discipline, and long-term leadership development—especially for those aspiring towards defence careers like the NDA. The process unfolds in the following eight stages:

Stage 01: Admission Notification and Publicity

To reach deserving candidates from across the country, the admission notification is disseminated through a comprehensive outreach strategy:

- **National Newspapers**: Advertisement campaigns in leading dailies to attract candidates from across India.
- **State and Regional Newspapers**: Special focus on Rajasthan and neighboring states to ensure regional visibility.
- **Social Media Platforms**: Regular updates and promotional posts on Facebook, Instagram, YouTube, and WhatsApp groups to target parents and students digitally.
- **Internal School Circular**: A formal communication to all current staff members encouraging them to inform their family and acquaintances about the admission opportunity.

Stage 02: Online Registration for Entrance Test

Interested parents and students are required to complete an **online registration form**, available on the school's official website.

- Key details such as student's personal information, class for which admission is sought, and preferred test center are captured.
- Parents are guided through the process by the admissions team, and helpdesk support is made available.

Stage 03: Release of Admit Card and Test Center Notification

Once the registration is complete:

- Admit cards are generated and sent via email and WhatsApp to the registered mobile number.
- Information about the **test center location** (based on candidate preference and availability) and **instructions** for the test day are clearly communicated.
- The school ensures that each candidate is well-informed about what to bring and how to report.

Stage 04: Conduct of the Entrance Test

- The entrance examination is typically conducted on the first Sunday of February.
- **Pan-India Testing**: The test is held in approximately 15 cities including major metros and regional hubs such as Delhi, Jaipur, Lucknow, Chandigarh, Ahmedabad, Patna, and others, depending on the registration density.
- **Test Mode**: Both **offline (pen-paper based)** and **online (proctored platform)** modes are available to cater to accessibility and convenience.
- The test evaluates foundational knowledge in subjects like English NCERT, Mathematics -NCERT, Reasoning and General Awareness, suitable for the class applied.

Stage 05: Test Result Declaration and Invitation for Interaction

- Results are usually declared within 7 to 10 days of the entrance test.
- Qualified candidates are individually informed and invited for the next round: a formal
 interaction session.
- Communication is done through email, SMS, and WhatsApp, along with instructions for the interaction round (can be online or on campus, depending on location and availability).

Stage O6: Student Interaction and Readiness Assessment

This stage is crucial for evaluating the **holistic suitability** of the student for the Oasis Sainik School environment. It includes:

- One-on-One Interaction: Conducted by members of the academic and pastoral care team.
- **Vocal and Comprehension Check**: Assessing the child's ability to understand and express in English and Hindi.
- **Q&A Session**: Understanding the child's background, interests, goals, and personality traits.
- **Residential Readiness Check**: Evaluating the student's ability to adapt to residential life, routine, discipline, and co-living setup.

Stage 07: Admission List Declaration

- Based on performance in the entrance test and interaction, the First Admission List is published.
- Selected students receive offer letters along with **guidelines for fee submission**, document verification, and campus induction.
- Waitlisted candidates may be considered in the Second Round, subject to vacancy.

Stage 08: Admission Formalities and Reporting to Campus

- Admitted students complete the final admission formalities, including:
 - Submission of academic documents
 - Medical fitness certificate
 - Fee payment as per the schedule
- A reporting date is assigned for the student to arrive on campus with the prescribed set of uniforms and personal belongings.
- On arrival, students are oriented about campus life, hostel routines, academic structure, and co-curricular programs.

The carefully curated **eight-stage process** ensures that every student who joins Oasis Sainik School is well-informed, well-assessed, and fully prepared for the transformative journey of academic excellence, disciplined living, character formation, and potential defence career readiness.
